HB 2951, as introduced, requires that prior to election, beginning January 1, 2015, any candidate for county commissioner, county clerk, county treasurer, court clerk, county assessor, or county sheriff complete the training programs and seminars, as established by existing law, that are relevant to their positions and duties.

Fiscal Analysis

The requirement for candidates for county offices to complete training programs and educational seminars as provided by the Commission on County Government Personnel Education and Training does not include a provision where any public entity would bear any attendant costs. To the extent candidates will enroll and complete such training and any fees are paid to the Commission, the Commission would receive revenue from such charges, an amount that will depend on the number of courses and the number of candidates participating in the training events.
