**Fiscal Analysis**

The measure repeals the Cigarette and Tobacco Tax Advisory Committee, a nine member panel created to recommend to the Oklahoma Tax Commission rules to implement and enforce the provisions of this act and other provisions of law relating to the levy, collection and remittance of taxes on cigarettes and tobacco products. Repeal of the committee may result in travel reimbursement cost savings, as members are not compensated but are to be reimbursed for the costs of necessary travel.
