Fiscal Analysis

The measure repeals the Post secondary Oversight Council, a seven member panel created to review post secondary programs and courses for the purpose of recommending changes which may be expected to free resources for better uses, particularly through elimination of course and program duplication and through joint use of facilities and instructional personnel of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and the State Board of Career and Technology Education. Repeal of the committee may result in travel reimbursement cost savings, as members are not compensated but are to be reimbursed for the costs of necessary travel.
