**Research Analysis**

HB 3251 modifies the Competitive Bidding Act of 1974. The measure modifies notice and bids for contract in an emergency. The measure changes the contract threshold from \$35,000 to \$75,000.

The Senate amendment increased the cap from \$50,000 to \$75,000.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The Senate amendment increases the contract value threshold from the current \$35,000 (\$50,000 in the House Engrossed version) to \$75,000. No direct change in cost or cost savings is anticipated, as the increase in the threshold modifies the process under certain circumstances, but does not directly modify any potential project costs.
