**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB3280 allows for the creation of nonprofit health maintenance organizations (HMOs) which are deemed charitable and benevolent institutions. The measure also allows existing HMOs to apply for nonprofit certification and status. Nonprofit HMOs would not be subject to some of the insurance laws of the state, while other laws would still apply as long as they do not conflict with this measure.
