Research Analysis

SB1040 modifies the thresholds to calculate reduced child support obligation for additional parenting time. For noncustodial parents with 144-180 overnights, the multiplier would be 1.5. For parenting with 181 or more overnights, the multiplier would be 1.25. In the case where the district court and administrative court has jurisdiction over a proceeding to determine child support, the measure prohibits both courts from conducting simultaneous proceedings. Allows parties to pursue their action in either court, provided on motions to transfer, the district court would be given preference.
