Research Analysis

SB1056 creates the Professional Services Acquisition Act. The measure prohibits an out of state entity from soliciting a contract or contracting with a state agency to provide professional services rendered by allopathic physicians, osteopathic physicians, pharmacists, dentists, podiatrist and optometrists except when the out of state entity is in compliance with the same rules, regulations and laws imposed on a person or business whose physical place of business is located in this state. All state agencies would be required to review each of its out-of state contractors and contracting sources to confirm compliance with the Act within 90 days from the effective date of the measure (November 1, 2013).

A pharmacy benefits manager (PBM) would be required to obtain a license from the State Board of Pharmacy in order to provide pharmacy benefits management to a cover entity. Directs the Board to establish rules and fees for licensure of PBM's and allows the Board to suspend, revoke, or refuse licensure for noncompliance and other deceptive actions.
