**Research Analysis**

SB 1332 allows a driver education course certified by a state other than Oklahoma to satisfy the course requirements for a person 15 ½ years old who is required to take a driver education course in order to obtain a driver license. The measure authorizes DPS to create a knowledge test that may be taken on the Internet by an applicant applying for a Class D license. The bill provides that failure to submit the federally required medical certification for a commercial driver license shall result in an automatic downgrade to a Class D license. However, once medical certification is received by DPS, the license shall be reinstated to commercial status without the need to reapply. The bill also allows the certification fee assessed to a designated examiner employed by an Oklahoma public school to be waived by DPS.
