Research Analysis

The committee substitute for SB 1370 directs the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to offer a vision plan or plans to state employees and retiree beneficiaries. The plans eligible for selection must submit appropriate information. The measure modifies by increasing the requisite number of state-wide network from one hundred to two hundred. The measure also requires that providers be registered, certified, or authorized to conduct business in this state. The measure provides that any Oklahoma-based vendor that meets the requisite criteria be offered during enrollment period. Finally, the measure defines an Oklahoma-based vendor and authorizes the Office of Management and Enterprise Services, at the discretion, to select up to one out-of-state vendor as an offered vendor.

Fiscal Analysis

The measure provides that any Oklahoma based vendor of vision plans will have their plan offered for enrollment in state benefit offerings. The provisions also allow for one out-of-state vendor so long as certain criteria are met.

Employees enrolling in a such plan will be paying premiums for coverage. No direct fiscal impact to the state is anticipated.
