Research Analysis

SB 1397 modifies the definition of “all-terrain vehicle” to clarify that the vehicle is 50 inches or less in width. The measure modifies the definition of “recreational off-highway vehicle” to clarify that the vehicle is 65 inches or less in width.

Fiscal Analysis

This bill proposes amendment to the definitions of "All-terrain vehicle" and "Recreational off-highway vehicle" contained in Section 1102 of Title 47.

The proposals in SB 1397 are limited to the definitions section (47 O.S. § 1102) of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act (“Act”). There are no corresponding proposals affecting the administration of the Act by the Tax Commission. The proposed amendments to the definitions of “All-terrain vehicle” (ATV) and “Recreational off-highway vehicle” (ROHV) remove the seating and steering descriptions, while adding a width requirement of 50 inches or less for ATVs and 65 inches or less for ROHVs. Registration of these vehicles is not substantively impacted by this measure.

There is no estimated revenue or administrative impact associated with the proposed amendments in SB 1397.
