**Research Analysis**

SB 1508 modifies the eligibility requirements for individuals who are appointed or elected to the board of directors of a master conservancy district: Municipal employees are not eligible to be a member of the board. However, current members who are municipal employee may complete their term and run for re-election. The measure also increases the per diem from \$50 to \$100.
