Research Analysis

The committee substitute requires the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education to report for each baccalaureate offering for the preceding five years the average five-year graduation rate for full-time bachelor-degree-seeking students; the average student loan debt; the percentage of students employed within their field of study after graduation; the average starting salary and information presented to at the conclusion of the sophomore year projecting the level of debt. The information also should include other academic programs that are in high demand in the Oklahoma economy.
