**Research Analysis**

SB1668 amends the Roofing Contractor Registration Act.

Most roofing contractors would be required to register and/or renew yearly, and there would be additional requirements on the registration application. No advertisement or offer to provide roofing contractor services could be done without registration. The expiration and renewal timeline would be adjusted. The roofing firm's name and registration ID number would be required on all vehicles, job sites, and media such as signs, letterheads, and advertisements. Municipal building officials would have the duty to refuse a permit for any roofing job unless there is proof of registration or that the contractor is exempt.

The definition of a Roofing Contractor is expanded, with several exemptions. There are also extra exemptions given from the entire scope of the Act.

The Construction Industries Board would be given additional authority over any rules, forms, fees and fines needed to implement the Act, including the requirements for giving a commercial roofer endorsement. The Board would have the authority to inspect registrations and work and to investigate complaints or possible unlawful/unregistered activity. The Board would also be given disciplinary authority over violations.

A new Committee of Roofing Examiners would be given authority to assist the Construction Industries Board in enforcing the act. They would help establish application and educational requirements, and to assist in investigating violations of the Act. An Oklahoma State Roofing Installation Code Variance and Appeals Board would be created to review proposed roofing work that does not conform to existing codes or guidelines.
