Fiscal Analysis

SB1720 requires entities that supervise offenders on probation to conduct an intake and orientation, substance abuse assessment, criminal risk needs assessment, develop a treatment plan, conduct substance abuse testing, and monitor the compliance of the offender with all obligations and requirements ordered by the court. The supervising entity must also provide sanctions in the event the offender violates the conditions of probation. Because of the new supervision requirements, it is anticipated that costs for the supervising entity will increase. The fiscal impact would be dependent upon the number of probationers and the cost of the additional services provided.
