**Research Analysis**

SB1914 prevents arrest or detention under the Juvenile Code, or any adjudication in a juvenile proceeding, from being considered an arrest, detention or conviction. This applies to civil rights, or any other public purpose such as statute, regulation, or licensing.

This measure includes an emergency clause.
