**Research Analysis**

SB 2019 provides that the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation may investigate, detect, apprehend, institute and maintain actions independently or jointly with the Department of Public Safety involving larceny or theft of oil, gas or oil field equipment. The measure allows the Director of the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation, or the Commissioner of Public Safety to appoint up to twenty special officers, who are not to be salaried employees of the Bureau or Department of Public Safety but are subject to the orders and directions of their appointing authority. The measure allows the special investigators to impose administrative fines or investigative fines of up to \$10,000 per violation. Administrative fines are to be deposited to the OSBI Oil and Gas Theft Recover Revolving Fund or the DPS Oil and Gas Theft Recovery Revolving Fund or divided between the two agency funds.
