**Research Analysis**

The CS for SB 235 modifies the term “ex-service person” to include “veteran.” The measure redefines the term “Oklahoma Veterans Homes” to “Oklahoma Veterans Centers.” The measure places the centers under the management and control of the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs and specifics the duties of the Department. Finally, the measure restores title and repeals the following sections of law under Title 72:

- 1. Disabled Ex-Service Persons - Hawking and Peddling - Affidavit as to Record and Need Certificate of County Judge – Expiration
- 4. Complaint - Certificate – Revocation
- 21. Purchase of Record Authorized
- 31. County Commissioners - Burial of Soldiers and Sailors
- 32. Burial Expenses Paid by County
- 33. Establishment of State Veterans Cemetery
- 41. Rooms in Courthouses
- 50.3 Effect of Act Retroactive
- 50.11 Veterans of Naval or Armed Forces of Canada - Eligibility for Benefits Under Certain Conditions
