**Research Analysis**

The engrossed CS version of SB 294 would, during a natural disaster, state-of-emergency, or catastrophic event in which the state's number of licensed architects and professional engineers is insufficient, and at the request of the governor, exempts out-of-state licensed architects or professional engineers from liability for any personal injury, wrongful death, property damage or other loss related to the licensed architect's or professional engineer's acts in placarding and inspecting structures for safety and habitability that occurs during an emergency.
