Research Analysis

SB374 establishes criteria for boat rental businesses operating in state parks. The measure requires boat rental businesses to have:

- a valid written contract with the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department or the agency that owns the lake;
- a business license issued by the state;
- a visible, commercially accessible public location;
- a tax permit and any other required local permit;

Failure to meet the minimum requirements may be punishable by a fine up to \$500 or 30 days of imprisonment, or both.

Fiscal Analysis

CS for SB 374 provides that boat rental businesses operating in state parks have a current valid contract with Tourism or the state agency that operates the lake. Officials at Tourism state the contract is in the form of a use permit, which amounts to 10% of gross sales.
