**Research Analysis**

The CS for SB 396 restores the title. The measure updates statutory references and deletes and repeals obsolete language related to the transfer of the Oklahoma Human Rights Commission to the Attorney General's (AG) Office. The measure directs the AG to notify a state agency if it is determined that an entity with whom the agency contracts has engaged in a discriminatory practice in the course of performing under the contract.
