**Research Analysis**

SB 398 would allow any reserve peace officer who has completed the 240 hour reserve peace officer certification program and has maintained active service in the past 2 years to be eligible to attend a 360 hour basic training academy. The measure requires every law enforcement agency employing police or peace officers to submit to CLEET on or before October 1 of each calendar year a complete list of all commissioned employees with a current mailing address and phone number for each officer. Peace officers, reserve peace officers and tribal peace officers are required to maintain a current residential address with CLEET and must notify CLEET of any change of name or address within 10 days of the change.

**Fiscal Analysis**

According to CLEET, the “bridge” academy for reserve peace officers to become full-time peace officers will replace one of the five basic academies currently offered during the year. The bridge academy curriculum would include all skills training not covered in the reserve academy. The bridge academy will be six weeks shorter than the basic academy, so CLEET will save \$13,912 in cafeteria costs that would have incurred during a basic academy.
