Fiscal Analysis

The Department of Transportation will cause suitable markers to be placed upon the section of highway designated for the honoree, OHP Captain Pete Norwood. The enactment of HB 1666 (2011) provides that the costs associated with signage related to the naming of highways and bridges is to be paid by the group sponsoring or requesting the sign, except in instances of a naming of a highway or bridge to honor members of the armed forces who were killed in action. Cost for the markers is to be paid from private sources.
