**Research Analysis**

SB 792 creates the Oklahoma Crusher Act. The measure would require any person engaged in the business as a crusher to obtain a license from the Oklahoma Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission. The measure provides eligibility criteria for licensure. Requires the Commission to investigate applicants. A crusher is required to obtain proof of ownership from a person selling a used motor vehicle, trailer or non-motorized recreational vehicle to the crusher. Allows the Commission to adopt necessary rules. Provides criminal penalties for failing to obtain license and for false declaration of ownership.

**Fiscal Analysis**

CS for SB 792 creates the Oklahoma Crusher Act, under the authority of the Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission. The measure allows the Commission to set by rule the license, investigation, renewal and late fees for those licensed under the act. The measure further outlines fees and penalties for violations of the act. The impact of the measure is dependent upon the number of licenses and renewals sold, as well as fee and penalty revenue.
