**Research Analysis**

The CS for SB 853 requires any facility that provides diagnostic or treatment services for cancerous diseases and precancerous diseases to report any or all data and information necessary to maintain the tumor registry. The measure does not apply to ambulatory service centers upon signed affidavit that the center utilizes a sole source pathology laboratory. Finally, the CS restores title.
