Research Analysis

The measure provides that school district boards of education members elected prior to January 1, 2014, will meet education requirements outlined in State Board of Education rules. Members elected on or after January 1, 2014, must complete 12 hours of education instruction in legal issues including employment, due process, new laws and the Oklahoma Records and Open Meeting acts. Instruction also must include the topics of special education and ethics. Members must agree in writing to complete one hour each of instruction in school finance, the Open Meeting and Open Records acts and ethics. The education requirement for incumbents filing for reelection also must include one hour each in those topics and they may obtain the remaining hours required at a workshop, class or seminar addressing education issues.
