The measure proposes to amend 47 O. S. § 1135.2 creating a Legion of Merit Medal Recipient special license plate for any resident of Oklahoma presenting proper certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States of being awarded the Legion of Merit military decoration. Persons may apply for this special license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The annual fee for such plate shall be \$8 in addition to all other registration fees.

**ATTACHMENT TO FISCAL IMPACT–HB 1352–[Introduced]–Prepared February 9 2013.**

House Bill 1352 proposes to amend 47 O. S. § 1135.2 creating a Legion of Merit Medal Recipient special license plate for any resident of Oklahoma presenting proper certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States of being awarded the Legion of Merit military decoration. Persons may apply for a Legion of Merit recipient license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

Such license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Military Department of the State of Oklahoma. The annual additional registration fee for this license plate is Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be deposited in the OTC Reimbursement Fund.

There is no estimated change in state revenues or any administrative costs/savings associated with the proposals set forth in HB 1352.
