PROPOSAL: Amendatory 47 O.S. § 14-109

The measure proposes to amend 47 O.S. § 14-109 by adding feed mill trucks transporting feed to and from the farm to those vehicles excepted from the weight limitations for operating vehicles on the road or highway. The referenced classification of vehicles operating under the exception must purchase an annual special overload permit for One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
