**PROPOSAL:** Amendatory 68 O.S. § 341

In addition to violations of the Unfair Cigarette and Tobacco Products Sales Act, the measure mandates that the Tax Commission cancel the license of any cigarette or tobacco dealer who has been convicted for violation of any law pertaining to the use, possession, manufacture or sale of any controlled substance pursuant to the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act, or has been found guilty of a violation of any rule promulgated or order issued to control a new product or noncontrolled product or substance pursuant to 63 O.S. § 2-201 or convicted of a violation of any drug or narcotic law of the United States.
