The measure proposes amendment to Section 3 of Article 28 of the Oklahoma Constitution to allow wineries within or outside the state that are licensed by the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement Commission to receive orders for, sell and ship wine directly to consumers who are at least twenty-one (21) years of age within or outside of this state who have visited the winery in person.
