16 AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 1, line 20, delete Section 2 in its entirety
17 and insert the following:

18 "SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the
19 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
20 hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take
21 effect and be in full force from and after its passage and
22 approval."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 420 of Title 10, unless there is
15 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The Child Care Center Bill of Rights includes if a child care
17 center employee has completed the required training, the child care
18 center shall not be penalized if computer documentation is not
19 updated.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
