14 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and
15 entire bill and insert

16 "An Act relating to transportation; amending 69 O.S.
17 2011, Section 687.3, as last amended by Section 1,
18 Chapter 388, O.S.L. 2015 (69 O.S. Supp. 2015,
19 Section 687.3), which relates to the Emergency and
20 Transportation Revolving Fund; clarifying certain
vehicle definition; and clarifying language.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2011, Section 687.3, as
23 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 388, O.S.L. 2015 (69 O.S. Supp.
24 2015, Section 687.3), is amended to read as follows:

1 Section 687.3 A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury
2 a revolving fund to be designated the "Emergency and Transportation
3 Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject
4 to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received
5 by any donations, deposits designated by law, or appropriations.
6 All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby
7 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by any qualified
8 county or counties pursuant to subsection B of this section for the
9 purpose of funding emergency or transportation projects of a county
10 that are reimbursable and subsection C of this section for the
11 purpose of funding loans to purchase compressed natural gas vehicles
12 or convert fleet vehicles to compressed natural gas. No more than
13 fifty percent (50%) of the fund's balance at the beginning of each
14 fiscal year shall be expended pursuant to subsection C of this
15 section. The fund shall be invested in whatever instruments are
16 authorized by law for investments by the State Treasurer and the
17 interest earned by any investment of monies from the fund shall be
18 credited to the Statewide Circuit Engineering District Revolving
19 Fund created pursuant to Section 687.2 of this title for expenditure
20 as provided by law. Expenditures from the Emergency and
21 Transportation Revolving Fund shall be made upon warrants issued by
22 the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with
23 the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
24 approval and payment.

1 B. The Statewide Circuit Engineering Board shall develop and
2 adopt rules governing the application and qualification procedures
3 for counties seeking funding pursuant to subsection A of this
4 section. Such rules shall also specify criteria in determining
5 reimbursable projects and the procedures for reimbursement of the
6 fund upon completion of projects.

7 C. 1. The Statewide Circuit Engineering Board shall develop
8 and adopt rules governing application and qualification procedures
9 for counties requesting a loan pursuant to subsection A of this
10 section to purchase compressed natural gas vehicles or convert
11 existing fleet vehicles to compressed natural gas.

12 2. Loans shall be provided at no interest for a maximum term of
13 five (5) years.

14 3. Counties that borrow funds for the purpose of purchasing
15 compressed natural gas vehicles shall provide documentation showing
16 that an amount of gas- or diesel-powered vehicles equal to or
17 greater than those purchased have been sold or ~~otherwise~~ disposed of

14 Section 687.3. A. There is hereby created in the State
