8 designating the John Cooper West Sr. Memorial
9 Highway; requiring certain markers; providing for
10 codification; and providing an effective date.

12 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the title, enacting clause and entire bill
13 and insert

14 "An Act relating to roads and bridges; amending
15 Section 4, Chapter 61, O.S.L. 2015 (69 O.S. Supp.
16 2015, Section 1698.215), which relates to memorial
17 highway designations; modifying designation of
18 certain highway; designating the J. Cooper West
19 Memorial Highway; designating the Washita County
20 Undersheriff Brian Beck Memorial Highway;
21 designating the Monte John Tucker Memorial Highway;
22 designating the Judge Ray Dean Linder Interchange;
23 designating the Senator Owen Laughlin Bridge;
24 designating the Meteorologist Gary England Bridge;
requiring certain markers; providing for
codification; providing an effective date; and
declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 4, Chapter 61, O.S.L. 2015
2 (69 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 1698.215), is amended to read as
3 follows:

4 Section 1698.215 The section of U.S. Highway 81 in Jefferson
5 County from the junction of U.S. Highway 81 and U.S. Highway 70
6 extending north and then northeast to the municipal limits of
7 Addington shall be designated as the "~~Command Sergeant Major Benny~~
8 Medal of Honor Recipient CSM Bennie G. Adkins Highway". The
9 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
10 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

11 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.231 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The section of Interstate 40 Business extending west from the
15 Beckham County Line to one-quarter (1/4) of a mile west of the
16 Interstate 40 and State Highway 34 Interchange shall be designated
17 as the "J. Cooper West Memorial Highway". The Department of
18 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
19 name to be placed on the highway.

20 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.232 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The section of Old U.S. Highway 66 in Washita County beginning
24 at the western municipal limits of Canute extending one and one-half

1 (1 1/2) miles west shall be designated as the "Washita County
2 Undersheriff Brian Beck Memorial Highway". The Department of
3 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that
4 name to be placed on the highway.

5 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.233 of Title 69, unless
7 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 The section of State Highway 58 in Alfalfa County beginning one
9 (1) mile east of the intersection of State Highway 58 and State
10 Highway 11 extending east to the eastern municipal limits of Byron,
11 Oklahoma, shall be designated as the "Monte John Tucker Memorial
12 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
13 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

14 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.234 of Title 69, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The highway interchange of U.S. Highway 281 and State Highway 45
18 in Woods County shall be designated as the "Judge Ray Dean Linder
19 Interchange". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
20 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed at each approach to
21 the interchange.

22 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.235 of Title 69, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The bridge over Sand Creek on U.S. Highway 270 located
2 approximately nine (9) miles southeast of the municipal limits of
3 Woodward, Oklahoma, in Woodward County shall be designated as the
4 "Senator Owen Laughlin Bridge". The Department of Transportation
5 shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the bridge
6 bearing that name.

7 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
8 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.236 of Title 69, unless
9 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

10 The bridge over the North Canadian River on U.S. Highway 60
11 north of Seiling, Oklahoma, shall be designated as the
12 "Meteorologist Gary England Bridge". The Department of
13 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
14 on the bridge bearing that name.

15 SECTION 8. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.

16 SECTION 9. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
17 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
