7 An Act relating to memorial highway designations;  
8 designating the Representative W.D. "Bill" Bradley  
9 Memorial Highway; requiring certain markers;  
10 providing for codification; and providing an  
11 effective date.

12 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the title, enacting clause and entire bill  
13 and insert

14 "An Act relating to memorial highway designations;  
15 amending 69 O.S. 2011, Section 1600.1, as amended by  
16 Section 12, Chapter 372, O.S.L. 2013 (69 O.S. Supp.  
17 2014, Section 1600.1), which relates to requirements  
18 for consideration of designation proposals;  
19 exempting certain proposals from requirements;  
20 designating the Representative W.D. "Bill" Bradley  
21 Memorial Highway; designating the Sgt. Daniel M.  
22 Eshbaugh Memorial Highway; designating the Command  
23 Sergeant Major Benny G. Adkins Highway; designating  
24 the Captain George Green Memorial Highway; requiring  
certain markers; providing for codification;  
providing an effective date; and declaring an  
emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 69 O.S. 2011, Section 1600.1, as  
2 amended by Section 12, Chapter 372, O.S.L. 2013 (69 O.S. Supp. 2014,  
3 Section 1600.1), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 1600.1 Highways, bridges, and other facilities which  
5 are part of the state highway system may be considered for  
6 dedication in honor of individuals deserving of commendation for  
7 their active involvement in the project or for outstanding service  
8 to the nation, this state, or their community. Persons proposed to  
9 be so honored shall have been deceased not less than three (3) years  
10 prior to consideration. The provisions of this section shall not  
11 apply to the naming of highways and bridges on the state highway  
12 system designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces,  
13 members of law enforcement or firefighters fallen in the performance  
14 of their duties. The provisions of this section shall also not  
15 apply to the naming of highways and bridges on the state highway  
16 system designed to honor Medal of Honor recipients both living and  
17 deceased. Proposals for the dedication of state highway facilities  
18 should specifically state the accomplishments upon which the  
19 proposal is based.

20 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.213 of Title 69, unless  
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The intersection of U.S. Highway 70 and U.S. Highway 81 in  
24 Jefferson County and the section of U.S. Highway 70 beginning at the

1 intersection and extending east seven (7) miles shall be designated  
2 as the "Representative W.D. "Bill" Bradley Memorial Highway". The  
3 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers  
4 bearing that name to be placed on the highways.

5 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.214 of Title 69, unless  
7 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 The section of State Highway 9 within the municipal limits of  
9 Norman beginning at the intersection of State Highway 9 and 120th  
10 Avenue SE and extending west to the intersection of State Highway 9  
11 and 84th Avenue SE shall be designated as the "Sgt. Daniel M.  
12 Eshbaugh Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall  
13 cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on  
14 the highway.

15 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.215 of Title 69, unless  
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 The section of U.S. Highway 81 in Jefferson County from the  
19 junction of U.S. Highway 81 and U.S. Highway 70 extending north and  
20 then northeast to the municipal limits of Addington shall be  
21 designated as the "Command Sergeant Major Benny G. Adkins Highway".  
22 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent  
23 markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

1           SECTION 5.           NEW LAW           A new section of law to be codified  
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.216 of Title 69, unless  
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4           The section of State Highway 97 within the municipal limits of  
5 Sapulpa from the junction of State Highway 97 and State Highway 33  
6 extending north to the junction of State Highway 97 and State  
7 Highway 166 shall be designated as the "Captain George Green  
8 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause  
9 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the  
10 highway.

11           SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015.

12           SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
13 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.213 of Title 69, unless  
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The intersection of U.S. Highway 70 and U.S. Highway 81 and  
15 extending east for seven miles shall be designated as the  
16 "Representative W.D. "Bill" Bradley Memorial Highway". The  
17 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers  
18 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
