11 directing the Office of Management and Enterprise
12 Services to take action to assist the Office of
13 Juvenile Affairs in operating the charter school;
14 providing an effective date; and declaring an
15 emergency.

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AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the title, enacting clause and entire bill
and insert

"An Act relating to the Office of Juvenile Affairs;
amending Section 1, Chapter 201, O.S.L. 2014 (10A
O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 2-7-616), which relates to
the Office of Juvenile Affairs' charter school;
authorizing Office of Management and Enterprise
Services to exempt the Office of Juvenile Affairs
from certain conflicting statutes; directing the
Office of Management and Enterprise Services to take
action to assist the Office of Juvenile Affairs in
operating the charter school; providing an effective
date; and declaring an emergency.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

2 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 201, O.S.L.
3 2014 (10A O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 2-7-616), is amended to read as
4 follows:

5 Section 2-7-616. A. For the purposes of establishing and
6 operating a charter school, pursuant to the provisions of Section 3-
7 130 et seq. of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the Board of
8 Juvenile Affairs may serve as the governing body of the charter
9 school and may take any action necessary to serve in such capacity
10 and in accordance with rules of the State Board of Education. The
11 Board of Juvenile Affairs may promulgate rules as necessary for the
12 establishment and operation of such charter school and shall
13 establish policies and provide oversight for any such charter
14 school.

15 B. The Executive Director of the Office of Juvenile Affairs
16 shall provide for the administration and operation of any charter
17 school established and operated by the Office of Juvenile Affairs.

18 C. The Executive Director of the Office of Juvenile Affairs may
19 employ instructional and administrative personnel necessary for the
20 operation of a charter school and may contract with such personnel
21 for the terms and conditions of their employment or for the services
22 provided. Instructional and administrative personnel employed by
23 the Office of Juvenile Affairs shall be in the unclassified service.

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1 Such personnel shall be eligible for membership or participation in
2 the Teachers' Retirement System of Oklahoma.

3 D. To implement the provisions of this section, the Office of
4 Management and Enterprise Services shall have the authority to
5 exempt the Office of Juvenile Affairs from specific statutes that
6 are in conflict with requirements of operating a charter school.
7 The Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall take any
8 action necessary to assist the Office of Juvenile Affairs in
9 operating a charter school, including but not limited to:

- 10 1. Establishing a special agency account; and
11 2. Authorizing a surety bond as required by Section 5-116a of
12 Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.

14 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
15 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
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
