11 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and  
12 entire bill and insert

13 "An Act relating to the Oklahoma Cosmetology and  
14 Barbering Act; amending 59 O.S. 2011, Section  
15 199.10, as last amended by Section 8, Chapter 260,  
16 O.S.L. 2014 (59 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 199.10),  
17 which relates to licenses; prohibiting display of  
18 certain personal information; providing for  
19 redaction of personal address information; providing  
20 an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 199.10, as  
23 last amended by Section 8, Chapter 260, O.S.L. 2014 (59 O.S. Supp.  
24 2015, Section 199.10), is amended to read as follows:

Section 199.10 A. All licenses issued under the provisions of  
the Oklahoma Cosmetology and Barbering Act shall be issued for a

1 period of one (1) year. The expiration date of the license shall be  
2 the last day of the month in which the applicant's birthday falls.  
3 The public display of a licensee's personal residential address on  
4 the face of any license issued pursuant to the provisions of the  
5 Oklahoma Cosmetology and Barbering Act shall be prohibited on and  
6 after July 1, 2016, and such personal address information, if  
7 publically displayed on a valid license, may be redacted by the  
8 licensee until the license is renewed and no longer bears his or her  
9 personal residential address.

10 B. Applications for renewal must be made on or before the last  
11 day of the month in which the applicant's birthday falls, and shall  
12 be accompanied by the appropriate fees.

13 C. Any person who fails to renew the license within the  
14 required time may make application for renewal at any time within  
15 five (5) years from the expiration date of the license by paying the  
16 regular renewal license fee and a late fee of Ten Dollars (\$10.00),  
17 which becomes due two (2) months after the expiration date.

18 D. Any person who fails to renew within the required time may  
19 make application with subsequent renewal and penalty fees.

20 E. Before a person may take an examination to renew an expired  
21 license after a period of five (5) years, such person shall register  
22 in a cosmetology or barber school for the given number of review  
23 hours in accordance with the following timetable and schedule based  
24 upon the type of license held.

19 F. Each person holding a license shall notify the Board of any  
20 change in the mailing address of such person within thirty (30) days  
21 after any change.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.
