15 "An Act relating to special license plates; amending  
16 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1104.11, as amended by Section  
17 189, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (47 O.S. Supp. 2014,  
18 Section 1104.11), which relates to the Patriot  
License Plate Revolving Fund; modifying purpose for  
which funds may be expended; and declaring an  
emergency.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1104.11, as  
23 amended by Section 189, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (47 O.S. Supp.  
24 2014, Section 1104.11), is amended to read as follows:

1 Section 1104.11 A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee  
2 authorized by Section 1135.5 of this title for the Patriot License  
3 Plate shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate Revolving Fund  
4 created in subsection B of this section.

5 B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving  
6 fund for the Military Department of Oklahoma to be designated the  
7 "Patriot License Plate Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a  
8 continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall  
9 consist of all monies received by the Military Department of  
10 Oklahoma pursuant to the provisions of subsection A of this section.  
11 All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby  
12 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Military  
13 Department of Oklahoma for any deployment-related purpose for  
14 ~~Oklahoma residents who are~~ members of the Oklahoma National Guard or  
15 the production of historical documents, displays, videos, and books  
16 that capture the National Guard's involvement in overseas  
17 deployments and domestic operations within the United States for  
18 members of the Oklahoma National Guard, Oklahoma public school  
19 libraries, and civic leaders, as determined by the Adjutant General.  
20 Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the  
21 State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the  
22 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for  
23 approval and payment.
