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11 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and
12 entire bill and insert

13 "An Act relating to state government; authorizing the
14 Office of Management and Enterprise Services to
15 approve an alternative process for certain business
16 operations; requiring appropriate reporting;
17 defining term; providing for codification; and
18 providing an effective date.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 63.6 of Title 74, unless there
22 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 A. When unnecessary duplication or redundancies add cost and
24 inefficiency to routine processing systems, the Office of Management
and Enterprise Services (OMES) may approve an alternative process

1 for certain business operations, including but not limited to
2 accounts payable and travel and expense control at academic health
3 centers that meet or exceed OMES requirements. OMES shall establish
4 appropriate reporting as deemed necessary.

5 B. For purposes of this section, an academic health center
6 consists of an allopathic or osteopathic medical school, one or more
7 other health profession schools or programs such as allied health,
8 dentistry, graduate studies, nursing, pharmacy, public health,
9 veterinary medicine, and one or more owned or affiliated teaching
10 hospitals or health systems.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2016."
