AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and  
entire bill and insert

"An Act relating to the Oklahoma Viticulture and  
Enology Center Development Revolving Fund; amending  
37 O.S. 2011, Section 563.1, as amended by Section  
127, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (37 O.S. Supp. 2014,  
Section 563.1), which relates to the Oklahoma  
Viticulture and Enology Center Development Revolving  
Fund; transferring revolving fund to the Oklahoma  
Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry;  
requiring funds to be made available to the  
Department; providing for noncodification; and  
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

1 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 37 O.S. 2011, Section 563.1, as  
2 amended by Section 127, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (37 O.S. Supp.  
3 2014, Section 563.1), is amended to read as follows:

4 Section 563.1 A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury  
5 a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Department of ~~Commerce~~  
6 Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to be designated the "Oklahoma  
7 Viticulture and Enology Center Development Revolving Fund".

8 B. The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal  
9 year limitations, and shall consist of all monies distributed to the  
10 fund:

11 1. From the apportionment provided in paragraph 1 of Section  
12 563 of this title; and

13 2. From any other source in accordance with state and federal  
14 law.

15 C. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby  
16 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Department for  
17 the purpose of:

18 1. Establishing a Viticulture and Enology Center on the campus  
19 of Redlands Community College;

20 2. Developing viticulture-related and enology-related education  
21 programs;

22 3. Developing technologies, strategies, or practices that aid  
23 in the production of grapes and wine in Oklahoma; and

1 4. Increasing the positive economic impact of the Oklahoma wine  
2 industry on this state.

3 D. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants  
4 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by  
5 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise  
6 Services for approval and payment.

7 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be  
8 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

9 All funds currently held in the Oklahoma Viticulture and Enology  
10 Center Development Revolving Fund shall remain in the fund and be  
11 available for use by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food,  
12 and Forestry for the purposes identified in Section 563.1 of Title  
13 37 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

14 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015."
