AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, Lines 7 through 10, amend the title to
read

"An Act relating to the Office of Juvenile
Affairs; amending 10A O.S. 2011, Section 2-7-305,
as amended by Section 21, Chapter 404, O.S.L. 2013
(10A O.S. Supp. 2014, Section 2-7-305), which
relates to community intervention centers;
permitting centers to receive and hold juveniles
pending transportation to a detention facility;
clarifying when custody by law enforcement is
relinquished; and providing an effective date."

AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 3, Line 19, delete beginning with the word
"transfer" through the word "that" and insert
"hold juveniles for whom"

1 AMENDMENT NO. 3. Page 3, Line 20, after the word "available" and
2 before the period "." insert the following
language

3 "pending transportation by law enforcement to a detention facility;
4 provided, custody by law enforcement shall not be relinquished to
5 the community intervention center until detention eligibility and
6 bed availability are determined by the designated detention screener
7 and an order for detention is issued"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4. Page 4, Line 16, after the word "placement" delete
9 all language through the word and comma
"appropriate," on Line 17
