10 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and
11 entire bill and insert

13 "An Act relating to state officers; amending 74 O.S.
14 2011, Section 250.4, as amended by Section 3 of
15 Enrolled House Joint Resolution No. 1096 of the 2nd
16 Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature (74 O.S.
17 Supp. 2014, Section 250.4), which relates to
18 statewide elected officers; modifying salaries; and
19 providing an effective date.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 250.4, as
22 amended by Section 3 of Enrolled House Joint Resolution No. 1096 of
23 the 2nd Session of the 54th Oklahoma Legislature (74 O.S. Supp.
24 2014, Section 250.4), is amended to read as follows:

1 Section 250.4 Pursuant to provisions of the Constitution of the
2 State of Oklahoma from and after the beginning date of a term of
3 office which commences in, or after, January ~~1999~~ 2016, the
4 following officers of the State of Oklahoma shall be annually
5 compensated for their services, payable monthly, as follows:

6 1. The Governor shall receive a salary ~~equal to the salary~~
7 ~~received by the Chief Justice of the Oklahoma Supreme Court;~~
8 ~~provided however, the Governor shall not receive any increase in~~
9 ~~salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution~~
10 ~~of One Hundred Forty-seven Thousand Dollars (\$147,000.00);~~

11 2. The Lieutenant Governor shall receive a salary ~~equal to the~~
12 ~~salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a~~
13 ~~population greater than ten thousand (10,000) and less than thirty~~
14 ~~thousand (30,000); provided however, the Lieutenant Governor shall~~
15 ~~not receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of~~
16 ~~Section 1 of this resolution of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven~~
17 ~~Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);~~

18 3. The Attorney General shall receive a salary ~~equal to the~~
19 ~~salary received by the Presiding Judge of the Court of Civil~~
20 ~~Appeals; provided however, the Attorney General shall not receive~~
21 ~~any increase in salary as a result of Section 1 of this resolution~~
22 ~~of One Hundred Thirty-two Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty-five Dollars~~
23 ~~(\$132,825.00);~~

1 4. The State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall receive
2 a salary ~~equal to the salary received by a district judge; provided~~
3 ~~however, the State Superintendent of Public Instruction shall not~~
4 ~~receive any increase in salary as a result of the provisions of~~
5 ~~Section 1 of this resolution~~ of One Hundred Twenty-four Thousand
6 Three Hundred Seventy-three Dollars (\$124,373.00);

7 5. Each member of the Corporation Commission shall receive a
8 salary ~~equal to the salary received by an associate district judge~~
9 ~~in a county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000);~~
10 ~~provided however, the Commissioners shall not receive any increase~~
11 ~~in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of this~~
12 ~~resolution~~ of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen
13 Dollars (\$114,713.00);

14 6. The State Treasurer shall receive a salary ~~equal to the~~
15 ~~salary received by an associate district judge in a county with a~~
16 ~~population of over thirty thousand (30,000); provided however, the~~
17 ~~State Treasurer shall not receive any increase in salary as a result~~
18 ~~of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution~~ of One Hundred
19 Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00);

20 7. The State Auditor and Inspector shall receive a salary ~~equal~~
21 ~~to the salary received by an associate district judge in a county~~
22 ~~with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000); provided~~
23 ~~however, the State Auditor and Inspector shall not receive any~~
24 ~~increase in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of~~

3 8. The State Insurance Commissioner shall receive a salary
4 ~~equal to the salary received by an associate district judge in a~~
5 ~~county with a population of over thirty thousand (30,000); provided~~
6 ~~however, the State Insurance Commissioner shall not receive any~~
7 ~~increase in salary as a result of the provisions of Section 1 of~~
8 ~~this resolution of One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Seven Hundred~~
9 ~~Thirteen Dollars (\$114,713.00); and~~

10 9. The Commissioner of Labor shall receive a salary ~~equal to~~
11 ~~the salary received by a special judge; provided however, the~~
12 ~~Commissioner of Labor shall not receive any increase in salary as a~~
13 ~~result of the provisions of Section 1 of this resolution of One~~
14 ~~Hundred Five Thousand Fifty-three Dollars (\$105,053.00).~~

15 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective in accordance with
16 the provisions of Section 58 of Article V of the Oklahoma
17 Constitution."
