12 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the stricken title, enacting clause and
13 entire bill and insert

14 "An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of
15 Transportation; amending Section 1, Chapter 394,
16 O.S.L. 2015 (74 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 840-5.25),
17 which relates to the classified service; providing
18 exceptions for certain seasonal employees; directing
19 certain report to be submitted; providing an
20 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 394, O.S.L.
23 2015 (74 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 840-5.25), is amended to read as
24 follows:

1 Section 840-5.25 A. The Oklahoma Department of Transportation
2 shall be under the Merit System. Except as otherwise provided in
3 ~~subsection~~ subsections B through E of this section, all offices,
4 positions, and personnel shall be classified and subject to the
5 provisions of the Merit System of Personnel Administration and rules
6 promulgated pursuant thereto. This section shall supersede and
7 repeal any and all executive orders issued pursuant to the Oklahoma
8 Personnel Act to place the agency or its predecessors under the
9 Merit System.

10 B. In addition to offices, positions, and personnel that are
11 unclassified as specifically provided by law, the Oklahoma
12 Department of Transportation may place any employee initially
13 employed in the following positions on or after July 1, 2015, in the
14 unclassified service:

- 15 1. Five (5) executive assistant positions, assigned to an
16 assistant director;
- 17 2. Five (5) project manager positions;
- 18 3. Five (5) transportation coordinator positions; ~~and~~
- 19 4. Five (5) administration coordinator positions; and
- 20 5. Seasonal employees who work less than one thousand six
21 hundred (1,600) hours in any twelve-month period.

22 C. The Department may employ seasonal employees throughout the
23 calendar year. Such labor employed by the Department for a period
24 of time necessary to address a seasonal need shall be in the

1 unclassified service of the state as provided by the Oklahoma
2 Personnel Act of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such employees shall not be
3 entitled to paid leave, paid holidays, retirement, health, dental or
4 life insurance, and shall be exempt from any laws, rules or
5 practices providing for such benefits.

6 D. The Department, in its annual budget request, shall include
7 a summary of the use of seasonal employees, which shall include the
8 number of workers employed under the provisions of this section and
9 the total wages paid to these employees.

10 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.

11 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
12 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
13 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
14 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
