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14 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the title, enacting clause and entire bill  
15 and insert

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17 "An Act relating to the Adjutant General; amending 44  
18 O.S. 2011, Section 232.1, which relates to the  
19 leasing or renting of facilities; authorizing  
20 Adjutant General to waive charges or fees in certain  
21 circumstances; defining terms; providing an  
22 effective date; and declaring an emergency.

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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 44 O.S. 2011, Section 232.1, is  
amended to read as follows:

Section 232.1 A. The Adjutant General is authorized to enter  
into contracts to lease or rent facilities. The Adjutant General is  
authorized to waive all charges or fees, or any portion thereof, for

1 use of facilities by a charitable organization when such use is in  
2 support of civil authorities for joint training, natural disasters  
3 or other declared emergencies in accordance with rules promulgated  
4 by the Adjutant General. The Adjutant General is further authorized  
5 to waive charges or fees for use of facilities, or any portion  
6 thereof, by a charitable organization when the charges and fees do  
7 not exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

8 B. As used in this title:

9 1. "Civil authorities" means those elected and appointed  
10 officers and employees who constitute the government of the United  
11 States, the government and agencies of the State of Oklahoma, county  
12 and municipal governments within the State of Oklahoma, and  
13 political subdivisions thereof;

14 2. "Charitable organization" means an entity described in  
15 Section 501(c)(3) of Title 26 of the United States Code; and

16 3. "Military reservations", without limitation, include  
17 military installations, armories, air bases, and facilities owned or  
18 controlled by the state for military purposes.

19 C. The Adjutant General shall have charge of military  
20 reservations of the state and shall be responsible for the  
21 protection and safety of those military reservations, and promulgate  
22 rules for the maintenance of order thereon, for the enforcement of  
23 traffic rules and for all other lawful rules as may be ordered for  
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1 the operation, care, and preservation of existing facilities and  
2 installations on all state military reservations.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.

4 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
5 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
