9 amending Section 4, Chapter 268, O.S.L. 2014 (69 O.S.  
10 Supp. 2014, Section 1698.197), which relates to the  
11 Fire Chief Nolan Schmidt Highway; modifying name and  
12 end point of the highway designation; designating the  
13 Weatherford Veterans Memorial Drive; designating the  
14 President George H.W. Bush Highway; designating the  
15 President George W. Bush Highway; designating the 49  
16 Waiters Club Memorial Bridge; designating the SSG  
17 Travis Tompkins Memorial Highway; designating the SPC  
18 Charles Jirtle Memorial Highway; designating the 1st  
19 Lt. Brandon Landrum Memorial Highway; designating the  
20 PFC Ernest Ray Taylor Memorial Bridge; designating  
21 the PFC Jon Ross Townsend Memorial Highway;  
22 designating the SSG James "Bevo" Olivo Memorial  
23 Bridge; designating the Bill Milroy Memorial Bridge;  
24 designating the Trooper Nicholas Dees Memorial  
Highway; providing for codification; and providing an  
effective date.

AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 6, line 15, add a new Section 14 to read as  
follows:

1 "Section 14. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in  
2 the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.225 of Title 69, unless there  
3 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge over Wolf Creek on U.S. Highway 270 southeast of the  
5 municipal limits of Fort Supply shall be designated as the "Cpl.  
6 Mickey R. Alexander Memorial Bridge". The Department of  
7 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that  
8 name to be placed on the bridge."  
9

10 AMENDMENT NO. 2. Page 7, insert a new Section 15 to read as  
11 follows:

12 "SECTION 15. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.226 of Title 69, unless  
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The section of State Highway 78 beginning at the municipal  
16 limits of Tishomingo and extending east to the junction of State  
17 Highway 78 and County Road N3590 in Johnston County shall be  
18 designated as the "Ret. Army MSGT Woodrow T. Cox - WWII POW -  
19 Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause  
20 suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that  
21 name."
