General Description of **Major Differences** between the current report and the version last seen and voted on in the House and the sections in which such differences are located:

√ Changes from engrossed House measure which were made in the Senate and contained in conference committee report/substitute (applies *only* to House measures):

√ Changes made in conference:

Authorizes the State Board of Education to not administer the writing of English tests in grades five and eight until the 2017-2018 school year or until the Board has developed the statewide student assessments for English-Language Arts and Mathematics, whichever occurs first.

Stipulates that the Board will determine which subject area or areas the ASVAB may be used in lieu of an EOI test, and clarifies that students will not be exempt from demonstrating academic mastery in the subject areas of Algebra I and English II and from taking the EOI test for Biology I. Additionally, the CCS stipulates that the Board will determine which subject area or areas each business and industry-recognized endorsement may be used in lieu of an EOI test, and clarifies that students will not be exempt from demonstrating academic mastery in the subject areas of Algebra I and English II and from taking the EOI test for Biology I.

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
