General Subject Matter: Higher Education-Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program

General Description of **Major Differences** between the current report and the version last seen and voted on in the House and the sections in which such differences are located:

√ Changes from engrossed House measure which were made in the Senate and contained in conference committee report/substitute (applies *only* to House measures):

Adds students who were in the permanent custody of the Oklahoma Department of Human Services and were unable to complete all the core curriculum courses to the curriculum requirement exception in OHLAP that allows students to satisfy this requirement by participating in an approved program for remediation of high school curricular deficiencies.

Expands authorization for students who are in the permanent custody of the Oklahoma Department of Human Services to participate in OHLAP after the tenth grade and age 16.

Updated statutory language to reflect changes made in the previous session.
