General Description of **Major Differences** between the current report and the version last seen and voted on in the House and the sections in which such differences are located:

√ Changes made in conference:

Section 1.

- Measure no longer applies to care received in an intermediate care facility for individuals with intellectual disabilities or to services provided through a home- and community-based services waiver.
- Clarifies that nothing precludes the Health Care Authority from filing a lien on nonhomestead real property of a medical assistance recipient.
- Provides that an appraisal of the property is waived in case of a judicial sale.
- Provides that a lien may be discharged by paying an amount less than the amount of the lien, if necessary due to the value of the property at the time of the sale or transfer.
