General Subject Matter: School elections

General Description of **Major Differences** between the current report and the version last seen and voted on in the House and the sections in which such differences are located:

√ Changes from engrossed House measure which were made in the Senate and contained in conference committee report/substitute (applies *only* to House measures):

√ Changes made in conference:

Section 2. Provides for notification of a school board member that has not completed continuing education requirements. Requires the State Department of Education to maintain a permanent record of the instructional hours and continuing education hours earned for each district board of education member.

Section 3. The school district board of education will declare the seat of a member vacant within 30 days of receipt of notice that the member has not completed their continuing education requirements.

Section 4. Stipulates that the State Board of Education must send notice before March 1 of each year to school board members that have not completed their continuing education requirements. Upon determining that a school board member has not completed their continuing education requirements, the Board must immediately notify the school district board of education and the local superintendent that the member did not complete their requirements and that the board is required to declare the seat vacant.
