PROPOSED COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to memorial highway designations; amending Section 4, Chapter 268, O.S.L. 2014 (69 O.S. Supp. 2014, Section 1698.197), which relates to the Fire Chief Nolan Schmidt Highway; modifying name and end point of the highway designation; designating the Weatherford Veterans Memorial Drive; designating the President George H.W. Bush Highway; designating the President George W. Bush Highway; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 4, Chapter 268, O.S.L. 2014 (69 O.S. Supp. 2014, Section 1698.197), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1698.197 The portion of State Highway 58 between the junction of State Highway 58 and Interstate 40 extending north to the junction of State Highway 58 and County Road ~~E980~~ N2450 shall be designated as the "Fire Chief Nolan Schmidt Memorial Highway". The

1 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
2 to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

3 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
4 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.213 of Title 69, unless
5 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

6 The portion of State Highway 54 from the junction of State
7 Highway 54 and County Road E1020 extending southeast to the junction
8 of State Highway 54 and 7th Street in Weatherford, Oklahoma, shall
9 be designated as the "Weatherford Veterans Memorial Drive". The
10 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
11 bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

12 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.214 of Title 69, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The portion of U.S. Highway 81 from five-tenths (0.5) of a mile
16 north of the junction of U.S. Highway 81 and County Road E0760
17 extending north to five-tenths (0.5) of a mile south of the junction
18 of U.S. Highway 81 and County Road E0720 shall be designated as the
19 "President George H.W. Bush Highway". The Department of
20 Transportation shall cause suitable markers bearing that name to be
21 placed on the highway.

22 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.215 of Title 69, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The portion of U.S. Highway 81 from five-tenths (0.5) of a mile
2 north of the junction of U.S. Highway 81 and County Road E0700
3 extending north to five-tenths (0.5) of a mile south of the junction
4 of U.S. Highway 81 and County Road E0650 shall be designated as the
5 "President George W. Bush Highway". The Department of
6 Transportation shall cause suitable markers bearing that name to be
7 placed on the highway.

8 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
