9 An Act relating to developmental disability programs;  
10 amending 74 O.S. 2011, Section 129.7, as renumbered  
11 by Section 43, Chapter 209, O.S.L. 2013, and as last  
12 amended by Section 9, Chapter 286, O.S.L. 2014 (61  
13 O.S. Supp. 2014, Section 331), which relates to  
14 leases of certain surplus lands; modifying authorized  
15 use of lease revenues; amending 62 O.S. 2011, Section  
16 166d, as amended by Section 455, Chapter 304, O.S.L.  
17 2012 (62 O.S. Supp. 2014, Section 166d), which  
18 relates to certain bonuses and royalties; modifying  
19 authorized disposition of royalties; providing for  
20 use of revenues during operation of Southern Oklahoma  
Resource Center; providing for use of revenues during  
specified time period; providing for use of revenues  
in programs to assist developmentally disabled  
persons; providing an effective date; and declaring  
an emergency.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 129.7, as  
23 renumbered by Section 43, Chapter 209, O.S.L. 2013, and as last  
24 amended by Section 9, Chapter 286, O.S.L. 2014 (61 O.S. Supp. 2014,  
Section 331), is amended to read as follows:

1 Section 331. In addition to the land described in Section 329  
2 of this title, the Department of Human Services, with approval of  
3 the Director, may lease other surplus land and property at the  
4 Southern Oklahoma Resource Center of Pauls Valley to an individual  
5 or individuals or to an entity. Revenue from such lease shall be  
6 placed in a special agency clearing account to be used for the  
7 benefit of the residents of the Southern Oklahoma Resource Center of  
8 Pauls Valley as long as the Southern Oklahoma Resource Center of  
9 Pauls Valley remains in operation and for three (3) months  
10 thereafter. Upon expiration of the three (3) months after closure,  
11 the revenue shall be placed in a special agency clearing account to  
12 be used for the benefit of Department of Human Services' programs  
13 for individuals with developmental disabilities.

14 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 62 O.S. 2011, Section 166d, as  
15 amended by Section 455, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (62 O.S. Supp.  
16 2014, Section 166d), is amended to read as follows:

17 Section 166d. All royalty monies received upon behalf of this  
18 state, any and all bonus monies received upon behalf of this state,  
19 and any and all delay rentals received upon behalf of this state, in  
20 connection with or pursuant to the provisions of any oil and gas  
21 lease covering any of the lands occupied by, or assigned to the use  
22 of, the Southern Oklahoma Resource Center of Pauls Valley, entered  
23 into by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services, shall be  
24 deposited in the revolving fund of the Southern Oklahoma Resource

1 Center of Pauls Valley and shall be expended by said institution in  
2 the same manner that other treasury funds of said institution are  
3 expended as long as the Southern Oklahoma Resource Center of Pauls  
4 Valley remains in operation and for three (3) months thereafter.  
5 Upon expiration of the three (3) months after closure, the revenue  
6 shall be used to support the Department of Human Services' programs  
7 for individuals with developmental disabilities.

8 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015.

9 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
10 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
11 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
12 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
