9 An Act relating to professions and occupations;
10 amending Section 1000.23, as amended by Section 3,
11 Chapter 223, O.S.L. 2014 (59 O.S. Supp. 2014, Section
12 1000.23), which relates to the Oklahoma Uniform
13 Building Code Commission; modifying powers and duties
14 of the Commission; and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1000.23, as
17 amended by Section 3, Chapter 223, O.S.L. 2014 (59 O.S. Supp. 2014,
18 Section 1000.23), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 1000.23 A. The Oklahoma Uniform Building Code
20 Commission shall have the power and the duty to review and adopt all
21 building codes for residential and commercial construction to be
22 used by all entities within this state. Codes and standards adopted
23 by the Commission shall be the minimum standards for residential and
24 commercial construction in this state.

1 B. All public projects shall abide by such minimum standards
2 and requirements; provided, nothing in the Oklahoma Uniform Building
3 Code Commission Act shall prevent or take away from state agencies
4 the authority to enact and enforce requirements containing higher
5 standards and requirements than such minimum standards and
6 requirements.

7 C. Municipalities and other political subdivisions shall abide
8 by such minimum standards and requirements; provided, nothing in the
9 Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission Act shall prevent or take
10 away from such municipalities and other political subdivisions the
11 authority to enact and enforce requirements containing higher
12 standards and requirements than such minimum standards and
13 requirements.

14 D. The Oklahoma Uniform Building Code Commission shall have the
15 power and duty to establish a code academy for the training and
16 certification process for all residential and commercial building
17 code inspectors. The Commission shall establish regional training
18 for the purpose of training the county and municipal inspectors in
19 the Uniform Building Code. The regional training shall be offered
20 at no cost to the participant and shall be funded from the funds
21 received pursuant to Section 1000.25 of this title. Each inspector
22 operating in this state on behalf of any state agency or any
23 municipal or county office may complete regional training and be
24 issued a certification for inspections by the Uniform Building Code

1 Commission on and after January 1, 2015. The training and
2 certification applications, qualifications and procedures shall be
3 promulgated by rules of the Commission. The Commission may
4 establish forms and procedures to implement and administer the
5 provisions of this section.

6 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
